Accommodations & Travel Protocol

AIR/GROUND TRANSPORTATION

Please be advised that all flight arrangements must be handled with our office to ensure proper scheduling. To ensure that reasonable airfare is obtained, we ask that your ministry prepare the airline ticket no later than 6 weeks before the scheduled service/event date. Please be advised that all flight tickets must be full-fare, unrestricted First Class/Business tickets. Apostle Greaves travels with his queen, Lady Patricia H. Greaves, on designated assignments. If so, please inquire about an extra ticket your ministry may select to purchase; however, there is no obligation to do so.

Upon arrival, we request that a representative of your ministry meet Apostle Greaves at the corresponding airport gate.

If Apostle is traveling alone, please send a male representative to receive him at the designated pickup location.

Please be advised that in the event Apostle Greaves agrees to travel out of State by car, travel expenses such gas and tolls should to be considered. Upon agreement we ask that you send travel directions to the reserved hotel and event/service venue to his executive administrator.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

When making hotel reservations, Apostle Greaves requests (1) a Non-smoking room with a king-size bed. The following list of hotels is permissible for reservations only: Marriott, Hilton, and Hyatt. As per the request of Apostle Greaves, room reservations are preferred to be on the highest floor of the hotel, closest to the elevator. In addition to these accommodations, we also ask that a working list of nearby restaurants be provided.

We ask that upon arrival, the reserved room key be available to Apostle Greaves. Please be advised that in preserving the integrity and reputation of Apostle Greaves, male representation should only be sent to pick up and drop off from the designated hotel. To preserve confidentiality and professionalism, please do not give out his room number or telephone phone number to any constituents of the congregation.

Apostle Vincent L. Greaves Sr. Bio

Apostle Vincent L. Greaves Sr., whose proud parents are the late Deacon Victor and Mother Rose Greaves, was raised in Brooklyn, NY. He faithfully attended the Redemption Church of Christ Bible Way under the pastorship of the late Bishop Arthur Lee Pearson. Through the grace of God, he was baptized in Jesus' Name at the age of 15 and received the gift of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in a heavenly language at 20.

August 1988. The Lord called him into the ministry under the leadership of the late Bishop Delric Pollins. In July 1990, Bishop Carey Robinson licensed him in the Bible Way Worldwide, Inc. organization.

January 1992. Minister Greaves founded the United Power & Praise Crusade, Inc. Many souls were filled with the gift of the Holy Ghost, and many were baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ for the remission of their sins.

June 1994. Minister Vincent L. Greaves was ordained to the office of Elder during the 37th Holy Convocation of the Bible Way Churches worldwide. Apostle Huie L. Rogers was the Presiding Bishop.

July 2, 1995. Elder Greaves became the proud Pastor of the Good Samaritan Prayer Room Church, Inc. He continued to work with the Bible Way Churches worldwide as the New York State Youth President.

July 2005. Under the leadership of Apostle Lawrence G. Campbell, Chief Apostle and presiding Bishop of Bible Way Worldwide, and by the approval of the Joint Board of Bishops, Bishop Greaves, Sr. was appointed as a District Bishop in the Empire State Diocese of New York, under the late Bishop Carey Robinson (Diocesan Bishop).

July 2006. At the Bible Way 49th Holy Convocation, Bishop Greaves, Sr., was made the Episcopal Diocesan of the United New York Diocese (now known as Northeast Regional Diocese).

July 2010. Bishop Greaves, Sr. was elected Assistant General Secretary of the International Bible Way Church of Jesus Christ.

July 3, 2014. Bishop Greaves Sr. was elected by the Joint Board of Bishops to the Executive Board of Bishops and appointed Chief Apostle and Presiding Bishop Nelson to the office of General Secretary of the International Bible Way Church of Jesus Christ, Inc.

May 13, 2016. Bishop Greaves Sr. was made interim Pastor of the Christ Community Church of the Apostolic Faith, Inc., in Peekskill, New York. Bishop Greaves was installed as Senior Pastor on Saturday, November 19, 2016.

July 3, 2019. Bishop Greaves Sr. was elected by the Joint Board of Bishops to the Office of Apostle and 2nd Vice Presiding Bishop of the International Bible Way Church of Jesus Christ.

July 5, 2019. During the 62nd Annual Holy Convocation of International Bible Way Church of Jesus Christ, was dually consecrated and installed as Apostle and 2nd Vice Presiding Bishop of International Bible Way.

March 16, 2022. Apostle Greaves Sr. was elected by the joint board of Bishops 1st Vice Presiding Bishop of International Bible Way to be installed Friday, July 7, 2022.

July 7, 2022. During the 65th Holy Convocation of International Bible Way, he was duly installed as the 1st Vice Presiding Bishop.

Apostle Greaves holds an Associate Degree in Graphics Design & Animation from Anthem College, a bachelor's degree in web design & Multimedia from Westwood College, a bachelor's degree in biblical studies from Anointed by God Ministries Alliance and Theological Seminary, and an Honorary Doctor of Divinity, Master 1 in Theology and Master 2 in Divinity, Doctor of Theological in Ministry Leadership from Acts of Grace Bible College & Theological Seminary.

Apostle Greaves has been married to Pastor (Lady) Patricia H. Greaves for more than twenty-five years. The Lord has blessed Apostle and Lady Greaves with wonderfully anointed children: Darlene (Greaves) Joseph, Samantha Hall, Stephen Hall, Samanda Morrow, Danaisa Greaves, Malisia Gentile, and Vincent L. Greaves Jr. Today, Apostle and Lady Greaves stand together in ministry on the Word of God.
